

shouting this to a team to build character and instill values to help them in the field of life. But this same proverb is even more vital in the spiritual sense. A Christian is a winner indeed who has established himself as worthy of the reward by virtue of his faithful perseverance. If someone guits before he crosses the finish line, he will never know what it means to experience the joy of being a champion for Christ. God did not desire to create a "special people. who have overcome darkness, (2 Peter 2:9-10) so they could sit in anguish & doubt, never knowing victory on their own. YOU ARE TO BE GOD'S CHAMPION. Spiritual success is ours to know and savor.

True championship is only accomplished by our holding to the truth of Christ's power. As you continue to grow in the faith, you will look ahead to the eternal victory which will be realized in hearing the words "Well done!" Although this has not taken place yet, you are still able to enjoy a sense of victory right now. Take joy from the words of **2 Corinthians 2:14.** "Thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place."
