God and Country



2016 is an election year. Multiple recent Supreme Court decisions, and now the death of Justice Antonin Scalia (the longest sitting justice) has brought considerable attention to the direction our country is headed. A majority of Americans believe our country is headed in the wrong direction. Some politicians recently said, we are one Supreme Court Justice appointment away from losing our religious liberty and other freedoms.

Christians for too long have fearfully stood back, remained silent, and failed to address the issues corrupting our republic. The words "separation of church and state" have been used against us long enough. They are not in the constitution yet many believe they are. Thomas Jefferson, often touted as the great church/state separatist, in a letter to Benjamin Rush spelled out exactly the meaning of the First Amendment Establishment clause was simply intended to restrict congress from establishing through federal legislation a national christian denomination.

The Oak Hill Church of Christ enjoys tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The same code requires Oak Hill as an organization to not attempt to influence legislation as a substantial part of its activities and it may not participate in any campaign activity for or against political candidates. How does 501(c)(3) affect Oak Hill members? It doesn't. As a Church we can take a stand for Biblical principles. As Christians we must stand for those principles in our voting. Like it or not, politics plays a part in religion in our country and we as Christians must do our duty to the country as part of our duty to God. How can God's principles prevail if Godly people do not get involved? They do not enter any area on their own, only by God's people. John Adams (signer of the Declaration of Independence and second President of the United States) said, "We have no government armed with power capable of contending with human passions unbridled by morality and religion....Our constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other." According to God's Word, God is active in the affairs of nations. **Daniel 4:17**; God blesses those who look to him. **Ps. 33:12**; He will abandon and punish the nation that spurns His will and chooses to live sinfully. **Deut. 28:15**. "Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people." **Prov. 14:34**.

The systematic banning of Christianity from our schools, our government, and the public square has only resulted in massive increases in immorality, crime, and social anarchy, and God's disfavor---be thankful for God's patience. Have the nation's current problems come as a result of Christ's teaching being extracted from the public arena? Could they be remedied by their being reinstated?
